Day Wise Program

Day 1 Welcome to LAPLAND !

Arrive in Rovaniemi/ Kuusamo via Helsinki and embark on a magical adventure

Transfer and check in to your cozy accommodation

Have some free time to unwind and rejuvenate after your journey

Explore city center & local shops

Spend the evening exploring the city center and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant



Day 2

Explore Roveneimi

Visit the Arktikum Museum & Science Centre

After a good rest, wake up and enjoy a delicious breakfast. Then begin your day by heading to the **Arktikum Science Museum**. At the museum, the kids can dive into interactive exhibits that explore the fascinating world of the Arctic, from the region's unique wildlife to the extreme conditions of the Arctic Circle. The museum's engaging displays and hands-on activities are perfect for young explorers.



After lunch head for a magical experience – Visit Santa Claus Village! Here you can Meet Santa Claus in his official office, chat and take a photograph with him.

Then visit the Santa's Post office where you can send postcards to loved ones with a special arctic stamp!

Step across the Arctic Circle line, which runs through Santa Claus Village.

Grab dinner on the way back to the hotel



Day 3

Day trip to Iso-Syöte – Outdoor adventure

Depart for a full day trip to Iso-Syöte by own coach Upon arrival, there is a welcome with hot berry juice and cakes. The group will be divided into three batches and will rotate so as to complete all three activities.

- o **Snowshoe** - Our trip starts from the hotel after we collect our personal gear and winter clothing. The trip goes through the deep snow covering the hilltop of Iso Syöte. Discovering marks and tracks of animals and birds in the snow. During the break, the guide will have a hot drink and cookies for you.

- o **Ice Fishing** - Upon arrival at the ice fishing site, your guide will provide a brief orientation and safety instructions on ice fishing techniques. Learn how to drill a hole in the ice, set up your fishing equipment, and bait your hooks. Enjoy the tranquil surroundings of the frozen lake and the crisp winter air as you immerse yourself in this traditional Finnish activity.

- o **Short Reindeer Sleigh Ride/ Husky safari** - Hop on a sled and experience a classic reindeer/ husky safari. Learn about the importance of reindeer in Sámi culture and savor the peaceful beauty of the snowy forest as you're pulled along by these gentle animals.

Aurora Hunting

As darkness falls, keep an eye out for any signs of the Northern Lights. Spend the evening scanning the dark skies for the elusive Northern Lights while learning about the science and folklore behind this natural phenomenon

Day 4

Arctic Snow Hotel and Arctic Wildlife Park

After breakfast, head to the Arctic Snow Hotel for two exciting activities:

- Snow Sculpting:** Start the day by getting creative with snow sculpting, where you'll receive expert guidance to craft your own icy masterpiece in the hotel's winter wonderland.



Guided Hotel Tour: Next, take a fascinating guided tour of the Arctic Snow Hotel, exploring the stunning ice sculptures, intricate ice rooms, and learning about the annual process of building this frosty marvel.

Ranua Wildlife Park

Arrive at Ranua Wildlife Park Tour / Guided tour with Lunch:

Upon arrival enjoy a group lunch in a cozy setting at Wild Arctic Restaurant Ranua.

Get up close to Finland's native animals, including polar bears, arctic foxes, and wolverines, on a guided tour of the Ranua Wildlife Park. Learn about the park's conservation efforts.

Northern Light Hunting

Take in the awe-inspiring beauty of the Northern Lights dancing across the Arctic sky. Marvel at the vibrant colors and swirling patterns as they illuminate the darkness



Day 5

Welcome to Helsinki

Wake up and enjoy a hearty breakfast and check out of the hotel

Head to Rovaniemi Airport for your flight to Helsinki. Arrive in Helsinki and proceed to your hotel. Once you've checked in and settled, take a moment to relax.

This evening head out to the Market Square (known as Kauppatori), a lively open-air market by the harbor. Here, you will enjoy some local shopping. Dinner in market square before heading back to the hotel



Day 6

City Orientation of Helsinki with Heureka Science Center

Spend the morning exploring Heureka Science Centre, Finland's largest interactive science museum. Discover hands-on exhibits and interactive displays covering a wide range of scientific topics

Explore a range of interactive exhibits on space, artificial intelligence, and natural phenomena. Enjoy hands-on activities, such as the Giants of the Ice Age exhibition, and learn through fun, educational displays suitable for all ages!



Rock Church

After lunch, make your way to Temppeliaukio Church, also known as the Rock Church, located in the heart of Helsinki.

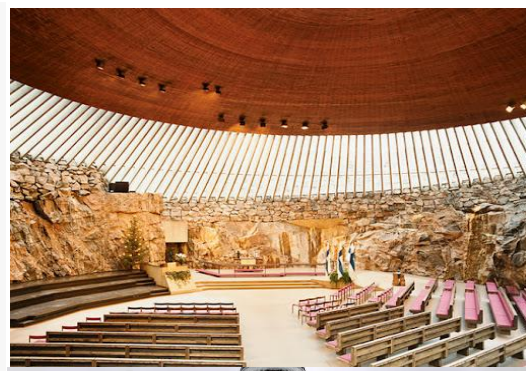
Explore the unique architecture and stunning interior of Temppeliaukio Church, which was carved directly into solid rock.

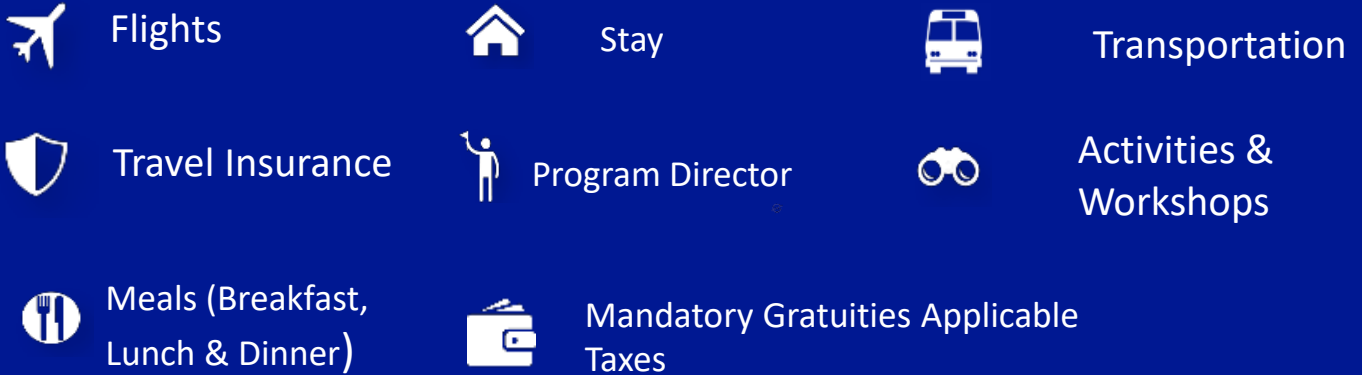
