Day 1

Dubai to Seoul | Explore N Seoul Tower

- Arrive Incheon International Airport (via Doha) where our local team will be waiting for you at the arrivals gate
- Check in to your hotel, get refreshed and settled. Board a cable car at myeongdong station to go to N Seoul Tower.
- Soak in incredible views over the Metropolis, from the observation deck of Seoul's second highest point, **the N Seoul Tower**
- After spending a beautiful evening at N- Seoul, make a stop for dinner before heading back to the hotel for some well deserved rest.



Day 2

Gwacheon National Science Museum and Lotte Theme Park

- Explore the **Gwacheon National Science Museum**, a landmark facility representing Korea's advanced science and technology capabilities.
- Experience science first-hand using your minds and imagination with the interactive exhibit items on display.
- Learn how the exterior of the main building represents a futuristic flying object, representing humanity's dream of the future, the creativity of exploration, and the potential of science and technology.
- Post lunch proceed to explore LOTTE World theme park the World's largest indoor theme park as well as Magic Island and the outdoor amusement park.
- Packed with a variety of thrilling rides and attractions, as well as entertaining goodies, this promises to be a day of fun!
- End with a nice local dinner and back to the hotel for some well deserved rest



Day 3

Bullet train to Busan

- Begin the day with a Bullet train ride to **BUSAN** and then enjoy half a day city tour of the iconic places in Busan.
- Learn about Busan's culture and history throughout the tour as you travel between each landmark. Explore **Jagalchi and BIFF square** popular as a gathering place for locals and visitors, featuring cafes, restaurants, and shops.
- Explore **Gamache Culture Village**. Wander through its vibrant, colorful streets filled with street art, murals, and unique installations.
- Head towards the **Songdo Marine Cable Car** attraction to take a ride in Korea's first cable car and enjoy the most incredible views of tranquil emerald waters, the surrounding hillsides and cliffs. Are you brave enough to sit in one of the glass bottomed cars?
- After Dinner, visit **Busan International Film Festival Square** , a cultural landmark in the city. Explore the cafes, restaurants, and shops and take in its modern design and central location.
- Back to the hotel for some well deserved rest

Day 4

Visit Hyundai Motors Ulsan Plant

- Start your day with a morning walk at Gwangalli Beach, sandy beach with marvelous views of the **Gwangandaegyo Bridge**, the iconic landmark of Busan
- After lunch, take a road trip to Ulsan for a field visit to **Hyundai Motor Plant**



- Arrive at the Hyundai Motors Ulsan Plant, which is one of the largest automobile manufacturing plants in the world. It is made up of five independent factories, with approximately 32,000 personnel producing an average of 5,800 vehicles per day.
- You will have the chance to check out the vehicle manufacturing plant. Then, explore the port that houses 76,000-ton ships to learn how they manage a massive plant and motor industry in Korea
- Have Dinner at a local restaurant, where you can enjoy Ulsan's famous seafood dishes
- Take a high speed train from Ulsan KTX Station to Seoul Station. Overnight in Seoul



Day 5

Discover DMZ Dora Observatory Panmunjeom

- Head 2 hours north of Seoul to visit the demilitarized zone between North and South Korea, better known as the DMZ
- Take in the views across the zone from the Dora Observatory and go into an infiltration tunnel the under DMZ built by the North Koreans
- Moving a head, you will see the Freedom bridge built to liberate 12,773 prisoners in 1953, used by South Koreans returning home from the North. Visit Panmunjeom, the village just North of the De Facto border where the armistice agreement that paused the Korean War was signed
- Lunch and K- pop!
Have you always wanted to be a K-Pop backing dancer? Well now you can live out those dreams in our K-pop dance class! Sing along if you know the words and follow the instructions of the professional instructors.
- In the evening, wander along Hongdae Street, filled with buskers and dance performances, making a walk here quite entertaining. Special streets such as ateliers' street, Picasso's Street, and Club Street are also must-go places for anyone hoping to fully experience the Hongdae area.



Day 6

Experience Cultural and Tradition of Korea

- Start your day with morning breakfast and then move to **Gyeongbokgung Palace** also known as Royal Palace of the Joseon Dynasty
- Explore the largest and perhaps the most beautiful of the 5 Palaces built by the dynasty in Seoul that exudes historical charms
- At the top, you will find Bukchon Hanko Village, a Korean traditional village of narrow alleys and traditional Korean houses called Hanboks. Although literally translating as “Korean Clothing”, a Hanbok refers to the traditional Korean clothing worn by men and women during the Joseon period. Today you’ll have a chance to wear this as you see the sights of Seoul.
- After Lunch in Gangnam Explore the Starfield COEX Mall, a mall that leads in trends and culture! Relax and entertain yourself at the Starfield Library, home to more than 50,000 books and magazines or visit the COEX Aquarium.



Day 7

Cookign class and visit to Korea's Universities

- Wake up early and start your day with breakfast
- It is said that to truly understand a country's culture, you must first experience its food. Learn more about Korea's by joining a Korean Cooking Class. Taught by one of the locals, this great cooking class!
- After Lunch, Embark your journey to one of Korea's top 3 universities - Seoul National Uni, Yonsei Uni, or Korea Uni while meeting and having fun with students and alumni and having fun with their real life story.
- Explore the beautiful campus, which boasts a mix of modern and traditional architecture.



- Have early dinner so that you can spend the evening in **Myeong-dong** - Korea's best-known shopping district, where the streets are lined with department stores and shops that sell brand-name cosmetics, clothes, shoes and accessories.

- Explore the sights, smells and tastes of Namdaemun Market, the oldest and largest traditional market in Korea. Visit this market and take in the countless shops and street stalls lining the alleys and selling clothes and food.



Day 8 Taekwondo Training & Departure

- In the morning get ready and check out from hotel, and proceed to dojang to see the World Taekwondo Headquarters
- Visit a Dojang, the Korean word for the training hall, where martial arts like Taekwondo & Tangsoodo take place. Engage in a training session led by experienced martial arts instructors. Learn the basic techniques, forms (known as "poomsae" in Taekwondo), and the philosophy behind Taekwondo and Tangsoodo.
- Lunch
- Experience K-Pop and view media art at the same time at the HiKR Ground, a homage to all things k-culture. The name "HiKR Ground" embodies the meaning that Korea (KR) will greet ("Hi") global tourists and become a playground.
- . Get immersed in Korean local tourism through various arts, experiences, and exhibitions or enjoy various media arts through the large media "HiKR Wall". Make your own K-pop music videos using the XR Live Studio!
- Head back to the airport for your flight home with a suitcase full of memories
