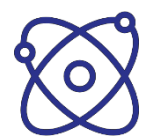

Arrival in Geneva

Welcome to the beautiful city of Geneva

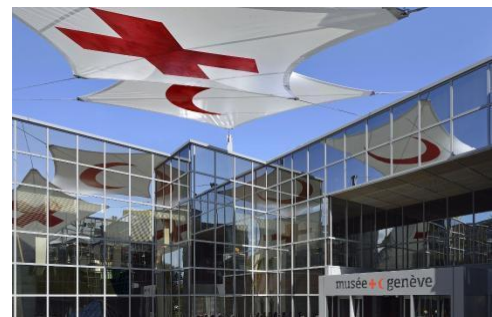
Red Cross Museum

Jet d'eau

Witness the famous fountain attraction at Jet D'eau make your way to the iconic Jet d'Eau, one of Geneva's most famous landmarks. Located on Lake Geneva, the Jet d'Eau is a large fountain that shoots water 140 meters into the air, creating a spectacular sight against the backdrop of the lake and the Alps.

CERN

Swiss Hotel Management School

Maison Cailler - Chocolate Factory

Explore the Maison Cailler chocolate factory and learn about the history of chocolate-making in Switzerland. Take a guided tour to see the chocolate-making process firsthand, from cocoa bean to delicious chocolate bars. Don't forget to indulge in some chocolate tasting!

Cheese Factory

Discover the art of Swiss cheese-making and learn about the production process behind famous Swiss cheeses like Gruyère. Enjoy cheese tastings and perhaps even try your hand at making cheese

Day 4

Chateau De Chillon

Charlie Chaplin Museum
