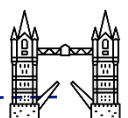

## Day 1 Welcome to London



- Arrive at London Airport, and transfer to the hotel
- Settle into your accommodation, and later meet your local guide at the hotel lobby who will explain rules and safety guidelines
- Begin your exploration with a walking tour of Trafalgar Square, one of London's most iconic landmarks. Enjoy the lively atmosphere and street performers that often entertain visitors.
- Capture some memorable photos with the iconic lion statues.
- Visit the National Gallery and marvel the impressive architecture of the national gallery
- Dinner at a local restaurant

## Day 2 Explore London's Iconic Landmarks



- Start your morning with some of the world's most recognizable faces with a trip to Madame Tussauds

- Meet and greet with famous , celebrities, political figures, and stars on stage and screen in this London institution.
- Continue your journey with a walking tour of Westminster and immerse yourself in history at the British Museum, venture to London's vibrant East End
- Board a coach for a guided tour of central London's landmarks, providing panoramic views and historical insights.
- Catch a glimpse of 10 Downing Street, Westminster Bridge, St James's Park, Palace of Westminster, home to the Houses of Parliament, and the iconic Big Ben clock tower.
- Arrive at Buckingham Palace, the official residence of the British monarch. Witness the Changing of the Guard ceremony
- Head across London and back in time to 1066 as you explore the Tower of London, built by William the Conqueror himself
- Learn about the Norman conquest and the very first stone castle built in Britain
- In the evening, enjoy a traditional British meal at a local restaurant.

## Day 3 London University Tour



- Take a university walking tour of University College London or similar, one of the oldest universities in London and is home to 40,000 students
- Gain insights into higher education in the UK and opportunities for further study
- Head towards the British Museum and explore the galleries at your own pace

- Listen to the museum's treasures by downloading new Audio App
- Explore the Tate Modern, one of the world's leading contemporary art museums, housed in a converted power station on the South Bank of the Thames.
- Conclude your day with a visit to Oxford Street for a spot of retail-therapy.

Day 4

Exploring London's Cultural Treasures



- Start your day with a morning breakfast and head towards London eye , offering panoramic views of the city skyline.
- Enjoy a leisurely ride in one of the glass pods as you ascend slowly, taking in breathtaking panoramic views of London and its landmarks, including the River Thames, Big Ben, Buckingham Palace, and more.
- Head over to the lively West End district, known for its bustling streets, iconic theaters, and vibrant atmosphere. Take a stroll through Piccadilly Circus, one of London's most famous intersections, and admire the dazzling array of lights and billboards.
- In the evening indulge in a delicious dinner at one of the many restaurants in the area, offering some traditional British food dining options.



- Board the coach for a scenic journey to Oxford, known as the "City of Dreaming Spires"
- Embark on a guided walking tour of Oxford's main attractions, including the renowned Bodleian Library, one of the oldest libraries in Europe.
- Experience the rich heritage of Oxford University with a guided tour of one of its prestigious colleges.
- Visit either the Ashmolean Museum, Britain's oldest public museum, housing a diverse collection of art and artifacts, OR
- Visit the Pitt Rivers Museum, renowned for its archaeological treasures and ethnographic displays.
- Take a stroll around Oxford College, soaking in the serene ambiance and picturesque surroundings.
- Return to London, reflecting on the day's discoveries and experiences in Oxford.

## Day 6 Explore London's Historical and Cultural Gems



- Rise early and prepare for your excursion out of London to visit the historic Windsor Castle, the official residence of the British monarch. Board your coach and enjoy a scenic journey through the English countryside as you make your way to Windsor.
- Upon arrival at Windsor Castle, embark on a guided tour of this magnificent royal residence. Explore the grand State Apartments, adorned with priceless works of art and opulent furnishings, and marvel at the stunning St. George's Chapel, a masterpiece of medieval architecture and the final resting place of many monarchs, including King Henry VIII.
