## Day Wise Program

### Day 1

#### Arrival in Hanoi

Welcome to Hanoi, Vietnam's vibrant capital. Known for its French colonial architecture, tree-lined boulevards, scenic lakes, and bustling Old Quarter, Hanoi is a city full of charm.

Check in to the hotel and after a quick freshen up proceed for a half day tour of Hanoi

A walking tour in Hanoi offers an immersive stroll through the bustling Old Quarter, where you'll explore narrow alleys, local markets, colonial architecture, and hidden temples



It often includes stops at street food stalls, historic sites like Hoan Kiem Lake, Hanoi opera house, and insights into daily Vietnamese life and culture.

Later head to the **Temple of Literature**: Founded in 1070, this peaceful site is **Vietnam's first university**. As the first university of Vietnam, the Temple of Literature is a popular cultural and historical relic in every Hanoi tour. Here, you will have a deeper understanding of Vietnam's history of development from the early days. Explore its beautiful gardens and well-preserved architecture.

## Day 2 Ha Long Bay Excursion with Sightseeing

Early morning, depart for the stunning Ha Long Bay. The 3-hour drive will take you through the lush farmlands of the Red River Delta.

**Boat Cruise on Ha Long Bay:** Board a private day cruise to explore the UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy breathtaking views of towering limestone islands, colorful floating villages, and crystal-clear waters. Sail past dramatic rock formations, islets, and serene coves.

## Day 3 Hanoi Cultural & Historical Exploration

Start your day at the **Hanoi History Museum**, where centuries of Vietnamese history come to life. From ancient dynasties to the colonial era and revolutionary struggles, this museum offers a fascinating overview through artifacts, photographs, and immersive exhibits.

Whether you're a history buff or a curious traveler, this museum sets a powerful tone for understanding the spirit of Hanoi.

Next, step into the haunting yet compelling world of **Hoa Lo Prison, famously known as the "Hanoi Hilton."** This stark but moving site reveals the harsh realities faced by Vietnamese revolutionaries and later, American POWs.

As you walk through the dim corridors and preserved cells, the exhibits & original artifacts will paint a vivid picture of endurance, sacrifice, and most importantly survival !



In the afternoon, return to central Hanoi for more iconic sights:

•**Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum:** Visit the final resting place of Vietnam's revered leader. This solemn site is rich in symbolism and national pride, and your guide will share stories that bring Ho Chi Minh's legacy to life.

•**Ho Chi Minh's Stilt House:** Just behind the mausoleum, explore the modest wooden house where "Uncle Ho" lived and worked. It offers a glimpse into his humble lifestyle and deep connection to the people.

End the day with a walk through Hanoi's bustling Old Quarter. This vibrant maze of narrow streets, each named after a traditional trade, is the perfect place to experience local life. Discover hidden temples, shop for handicrafts, or simply soak in the atmosphere of this lively, historic district.



## Day 4

### Welcome to Ho Chi Minh City

Arrive in Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) by flight . The largest city in Vietnam, located in the south. It's the country's economic and commercial hub, known for its energy, skyscrapers, and business scene.

Sightseeing in Ho Chi Minh City:

- Reunification Hall:** Visit this historic building, where the fall of Saigon marked the end of the Vietnam War.
- War Remnants Museum:** witness the impact of the Vietnam War through gripping exhibitions and powerful imagery.
- French Colonial Landmarks:** marvel at buildings like the Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Central Post Office, and the Opera House.

## Day 5

### Explore the Ho Chi Minh city formerly known as Saigon !

After Breakfast proceed to **Cu Chi Tunnels**

•Visit the famous Cu Chi Tunnels, an incredible underground network used by Vietnamese fighters during the war. Explore the tunnels to understand how they were built and used as shelters during combat.

After a quick local lunch we will proceed to watch a water puppet show.



Enjoy a water puppet show in Ho Chi Minh City which is a captivating traditional performance where wooden puppets dance on water, accompanied by live Vietnamese folk music. It brings to life rural legends, myths, and daily life scenes in a fun, family-friendly format

Finish the day with a visit to the Ben Thanh Market, where one can experience local culture, shop for souvenirs, clothing, handicrafts, and sample Vietnamese street food like pho, banh xeo, and fresh spring rolls.



## Day 6

### Mekong Delta- A hands on lesson in rural Vietnamese life

Depart from Ho Chi Minh City for a scenic drive to the Mekong Delta, known as the "Rice Bowl of Vietnam."

Enjoy views of lush rice paddies, fruit orchards, and village life along the way.

Board a traditional wooden boat to explore the delta's network of rivers and canals. Visit a local family-run home business to learn about traditional rice paper making, coconut candy production, and other artisanal crafts.

Enjoy a homemade Vietnamese lunch with a local family in their home. Experience warm hospitality and get a taste of authentic rural cuisine made with fresh local ingredients.

Head back to Ho Chi Minh City in the evening for dinner and overnight .



## Day 7

### Ho Chi Minh City to Dubai

This morning after breakfast check out of your hotel and depart Ho Chi Minh City for a fruit orchard visit . Embark a walking tour through lush gardens of mango, rambutan, dragon fruit, and more, and learn hands-on cultivation techniques directly from local farmers

Upon your return get some free time to shop for some local souvenirs and take a piece of Vietnam with you as you head to the airport for your flight back home.
